TUITION FEE REFUND POLICY

The policy outlined below will apply to a student who withdraws from the high school program after paying fee for either ONE semester or TWO semesters.

For this registered student, the refund will be calculated based on the starting date of the period for which the student has paid tuition fees.

1. The application fee is non-refundable.
2. No refund of paid tuition fees will be granted if a student withdraws, for whatever reasons.
3. No refund of paid tuition fees will be granted if the student is found in violation of school regulations and has been asked to withdraw from the school.

For International Students ONLY

- Ⓢ The same refund policy stated above applies to the international student. However, if the study permit is not approved by Immigration Canada, a **full** refund of all fees, except the application fee of \$200 and the processing fee of \$200 (total \$400), will be granted upon written proof (original) of such a refusal. The applicant must prove that the application process has been pursued in a practical, diligent and progressive manner; otherwise, the application will be considered to be an “abandonment” and no refund may be granted.
- Ⓢ A student who requests a Letter of Acceptance (LOA) from Royal School of Canada, for the purpose of applying for a VISA extension and has paid tuition fee of at least one semester (i.e., \$ 6,000), is entitled to receive tuition refund if the VISA extension application is rejected. The refunded quantum is the difference between the paid tuition and the sum equivalent to the tuition fees for two courses.
- Ⓢ Royal School of Canada adopts different tuition fees for local and international students. If an international student becomes a landed immigrant during the course of study, the local fee will take effect in the subsequent semester provided that documentary evidence is produced.
